Scholarships for students to study Mandarin language at NTU

NTU aims to provide at least 5 students every year with scholarship to focus on intensive Mandarin language studies in one of NTU's Mandarin language programs. The goal is to support overseas students in improving their Mandarin language proficiency through immersive Mandarin-learning programs and obtain an in-depth understanding of the Mandarin language through cultural immersion. Through each of the Mandarin language courses, students will be required to complete at least 15 hours of coursework per week.

1. Long-term scholarship (3, 6, 9, or 12 months)

Students may choose to study at either the International Chinese Language Program (ICLP) or the Chinese Language Division (CLD), both of which belong to NTU. During their attendance in the program, students will receive **a monthly scholarship of NTD 25,000** (approx. USD 800) from NTU, and the amount of scholarship received depends on the length of the period: one or multiple quarter-long courses at ICLP or CLD.

2. Short-term scholarship (3-6 weeks)

Students enroll in the NTU Plus Academy-Chinese Language and Culture program and receive **a scholarship of NTD 6,000 (approx. USD 200) per week** for their attendance in the program. This program has been designed for students of all levels, beginning or advanced, who want to improve their Chinese fluency.

Other than the scholarship opportunities above for inbound students, NTU could also send a Mandarin teacher or teaching assistant (NTU students) to partner university for one academic year or semester. Sponsorship for the teacher or assistant would be co-funded by NTU and partner university.
