We are pleased to inform you that our 2024 collaborative projects have been fully reviewed and the approved projects/teams will be notified shortly. It is expected that the collaboration and exchange activities between the two sides will begin soon in December.

At the same time, in order to further expand the exchange of scholars, UAAT has recently approved the UAAT International Young Visiting Scholar Program (see Attachment 1, 2). This mobility program invites young scholars from UAAT's international partner university systems or university alliances for a short-term (1-3 months) visit to UAAT's member universities, aiming to help international young scholars to make connection to UAAT universities/scholars and to initiate research, teaching, or innovation and entrepreneurship collaboration.

Here, we would like to ask your assistance in announcing and promoting this program in your university system/alliance and your university. UAAT also invites recommendation of **outstanding international young scholars** and **doctoral researchers** under the age of 45 from our partner university alliances/systems. If your system/alliance has a suitable list of recommendations, please provide it to us (as in **Attachment 3**) by **October 15**. The UAAT Secretariat will actively contact and help the recommended candidates to apply for the grant (e.g., help match a host university/scholar in UAAT, if necessary).

Aside from the established collaboration projects, we wish that this new young visiting scholar program will further enrich mutual collaboration and talent exchanges and strengthen ties between your university system/alliance and UAAT.
